

NATO Summit 2019

The event, which is part of the NATO 70th Anniversary London Summit, will attract worldwide media interest. The main event will take place in Hertfordshire however there will be ancillary events taking place within the footprint shown on Page 2 & 3.

The Metropolitan Police Service have been liaising with the hotels, businesses and partner agencies for some considerable time, and want to reassure the community that the event will be policed proportionately.

Such a high profile event will cause some disruption so we aim to ensure that any impact on the local residents, businesses and visitors is kept to an absolute minimum and will be working closely with our partners to achieve this.

We are sharing information ahead of the event in order to allow residents the time to plan accordingly and mitigate the impact it may have on their day to day lives.

There will be several road closures in place for either all or part of the event's duration. Details of these are displayed on a map overleaf.

There will be a **proportionate police presence** in the vicinity of the closures to facilitate access for residents and essential services.

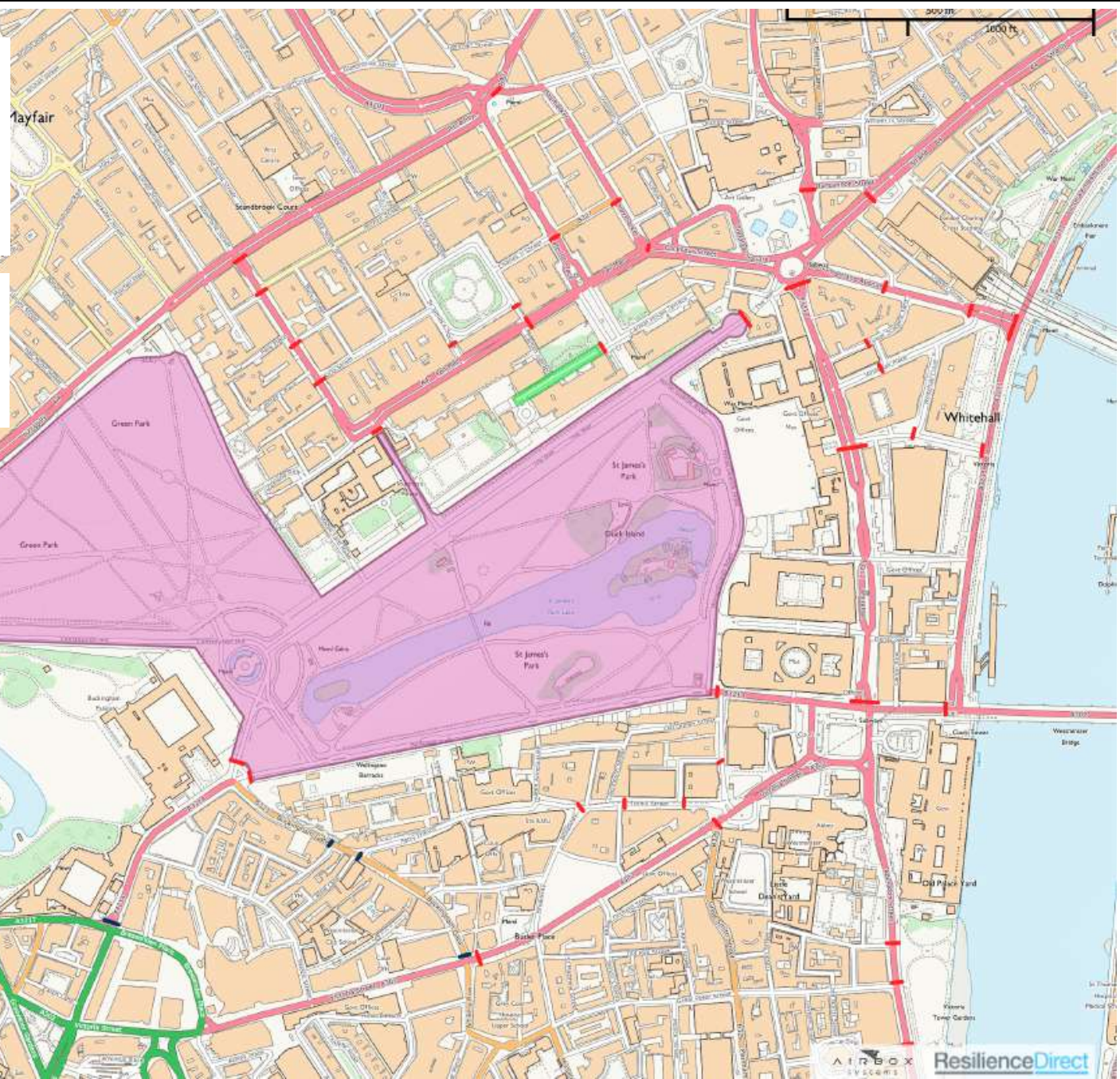
Increased traffic congestion is anticipated therefore residents, businesses and visitors are asked to consider their plans.

MEZ – Managed Exclusion Zone. Must be able to prove their purpose to enter the zone.

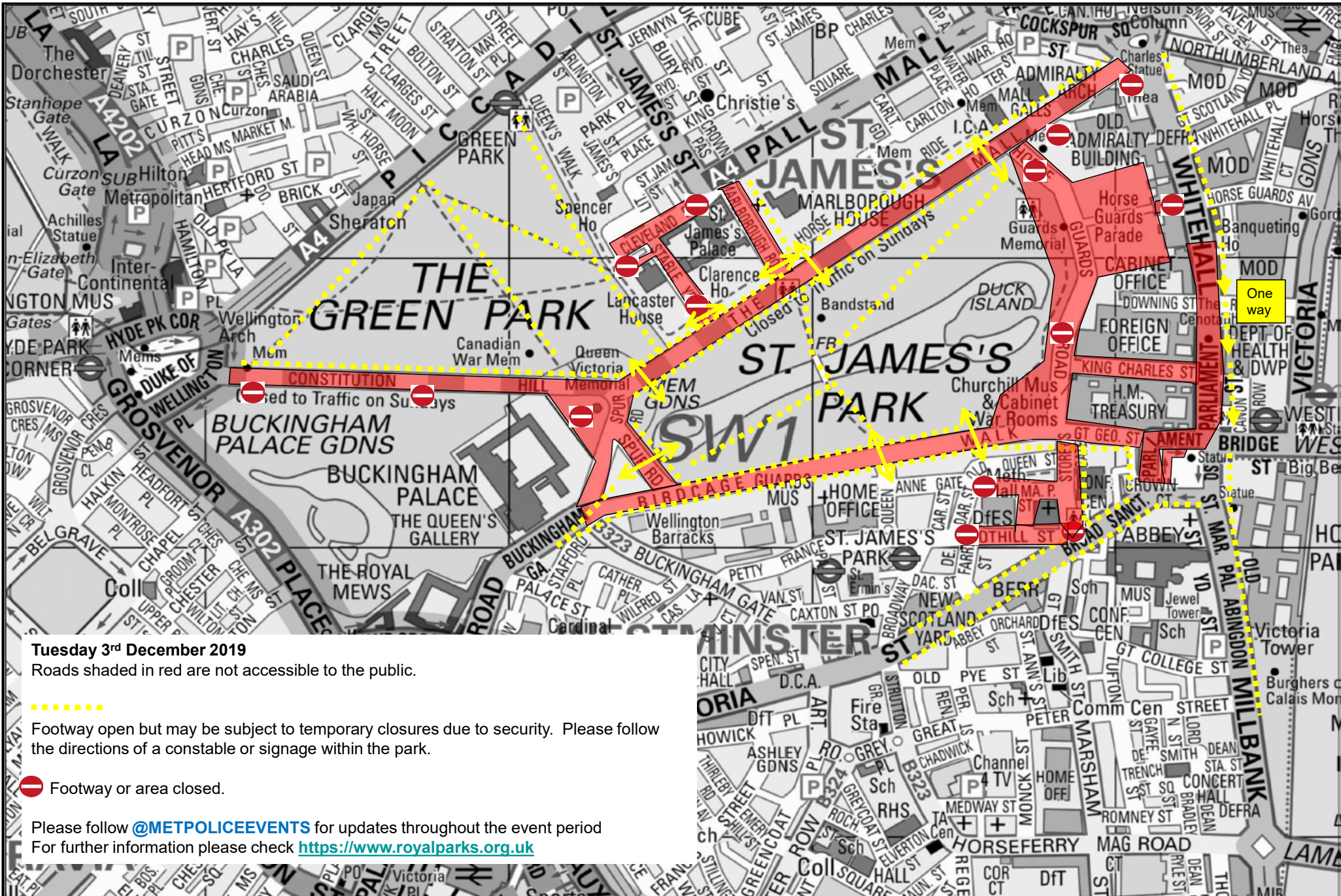
